

Pursuant to its power under Sec. 1.04 of the Tribal Court Code the Court hereby orders as follows:

### **Court Rule 16 Appointment of Substitute Judges**

- 1) Under Section 1.03(M) of the FCP Ordinances, the Executive Council shall appoint a substitute judge where all judges have been prevented from presiding by virtue of disqualification, illness, or absence.
- 2) In order to assist the Executive Council, when the need for a substitute judge arises, the Chief Judge shall contact the Wisconsin Tribal Judges Association or its successor. The WTJA shall randomly obtain the name of a tribal judge willing and able to serve as a substitute judge. The Chief Judge will forward the name to the Executive Council for appointment. If the Chief Judge is the trial judge being substituted, another Forest County Potawatomi Judge or the Clerk of Court may make the necessary arrangements as described in this rule.
