Length of Briefs

Dated: March 17, 2006

Pursuant to its power under Sec. 1.04 of the Tribal Court Code the Court hereby orders as follows:

Court Rule 27 Length of Briefs

Unless ordered otherwise by the court, typed initial and response briefs of a party or guardian ad litem shall include all information required in the caption pursuant to Rule 18, and have the following format:

Limited in length to forty (40) pages.

One inch top and bottom margins and one inch side margins;


Double spaced; and,

Type size/font no smaller than 10 cpi, or 12 point proportional.

Hand written initial and/or response briefs of a party or guardian ad litem shall not exceed 20,000 words.

Reply briefs and briefs by non-parties shall be limited to 10 pages formatted as above, and hand written reply and non-party briefs shall not exceed 4,000 words, unless ordered otherwise by the court.
