Use of Judicial Signature Stamp

March 3, 2003

Pursuant to and consistent with the authority vested in the Court by Section 1.04 **RULE MAKING POWER** of the Forest County Potawatomi Community Tribal Court Code, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that time of the Judicial Signature Stamp by the Tribal Court Clerk or any other Tribal Court employee shall be permitted only when all of the following conditions have been met:

1. An emergency situation exists or other exigent circumstances have arisen requiring the immediate execution of a document, paper, pleading, or instrument by the Tribal Court Judge;

2. The Tribal Court Judge is absent or otherwise unavailable to personally sign his or her name;

3. Use of the Judicial signature Stamp has been telephonically pre-approved and authorized by the Tribal Court Judge, which approval and authorization shall be so noted by date and time below the signature line; and


4. A copy of the document, paper, pleading, or instrument to which the Judicial Signature Stamp has been affixed can and will be made available to the

Tribal Court Judge upon his or her return to
Chambers.

Use of the Judicial Signature Stamp shall
otherwise not be permitted or accepted.
