Specificity of Motions



Pursuant to its power under Sec. 1.04 of the Tribal Court Code the Court hereby orders as follows:

Court Rule 23 Specificity of Motions

All motions must state with specificity the grounds and factual basis therefore. General assertions of violation of constitutional rights will not be considered specific. General assertions of insufficiency will not be considered specific. Such nonspecific motions may be denied without hearing by the court on its motion with notice to the parties of such denial and with leave to renew the motions in a timely manner.
