Holidays and Closing Court Offices**



Pursuant to its power under Sec. 1.04 of the Tribal Court Code the Court hereby orders as follows:

Court Rule 31 Holidays and Closing Court Offices

- 1) The Tribal Court office will be closed during those holidays designated by the Tribe.
- 2) In the event that normal business hours cannot be maintained or normal business cannot be conducted in the office of the clerk of court, any papers filed or fees paid on the next day business is conducted shall be deemed timely, if a deadline passed while the office was unable to conduct business. Halt of business operations or closure of the clerk's office, for any reason other than total closure of tribal government, shall only be approved by the chief judge upon request by the clerk.
